

NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF AUTHORS

Papers on major topics of international interest in any of the Earth sciences are welcomed. Papers longer than 14 pages require special editorial approval. There are *c.* 1000 words on a printed page.

Review papers. The Journal is also interested in publishing occasional review style papers, presenting a summary of the state-of-play in topical aspects of the Earth sciences. These may be longer than standard papers (typically up to 18 pages), subject to the agreement of the Chief Editor, but otherwise follow the same format. Authors considering submitting reviews should discuss the subject matter and proposed content of the paper with the Chief Editor (jgs@geolsoc.org.uk) prior to submission.

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- abstract (you may copy and paste this from your manuscript – 200 word limit)
- the name(s) of any funding organisations and grant numbers
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- covering letter, which the referees will see and should include highlights of the advancement the submission brings to the field and confirmation that the conclusions have wider importance beyond the study's geographical context.

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
